

Electric Cart Safety Guidelines



- 1. Operators of Electric Carts must hold a valid Drivers License.
- 2. Driving on sidewalks, handicap ramps and over curbs is prohibited.
- 3. Cart lights must be on while cart is being driven at night or during periods of poor visibility.
- 4. Arms and legs must be kept inside a moving cart at all times.
- 5. Passengers are not permitted to ride on the back of a cart unless it is equipped with a manufactured back seat.
- 6. If an electric cart is found to be unsafe or in need of repair, it should be addressed immediately.
- 7. At no time shall material be transported on top of the roof of any electric cart. Transport of materials other than "Tools of the Trade" is prohibited.
- 8. The identification decal issued by the WBSF Parking Department must be displayed on the front driver side, windshield or cart body.
- 9. The assigned department or production company shall be responsible for any property damage and resulting repair costs caused by their drivers. All accidents must be reported to the WBSF Security Department (4-1248).
- 10. All established traffic regulations, posted 8 MPH speed limits, stop signs and rights of way must be observed. This includes the use of signals as outlined below:



- 11. Parking is limited to designated cart spaces only, never in assigned motor vehicle spaces or in front of stage doors or fire hydrants.
- 12. When leaving the cart unattended, the brake shall be set and the keys removed.
- 13. Non-Street legal carts are not permitted to be driven outside the property line or any surrounding street, including off-lot parking structures. Only street legal carts which are properly registered with the California DMV and having visible license tags may be driven beyond property boundaries.
- 14. Unauthorized personal carts may not be used for daily job duties at any time.
- 15. The use of gasoline motorized carts or gasoline motorized scooters on Warner Bros. property is strictly prohibited.

Failure to comply with any of these policy guidelines may result in the revocation of electric cart privileges on Warner Bros. property. Electric cart operators observed driving in an unsafe manner further risk the loss of their automobile parking privileges.
